1. Cybersecurity Database Update

The TeraVM Cybersecurity Database is periodically updated as new threats (strikes) are discovered and added. The upgrade file is: upgradeCSDB_20250627-1615.tgz.

Note: The upgrade file follows the convention upgradeCSDB YYYYMMDD-BuildNumber.tgz.

There are 38 new threats/malware added to this release, bringing the total number of usable pcaps to 66,549 (plus 509 deprecated threats for backwards compatibility).

The list is attached to this document. To see the list, click the paper clip $\mathbf{0}$, or view using the method appropriate for your browser.

The Cybersecurity Database is organized into folders: the higher the number, the newer the folder, and the threats in it. Threats are also organized into categories, which can be filtered by tags.

2. Installation Instructions

Important: This upgrade, along with all future CSDB upgrades, requires TeraVM version 16.0 or later.

- 1. Download the upgrade file from the link provided by VIAVI Support.
- 2. In your web browser, go to the **Executive Utilities** page of your current TeraVM Executive. Use https://centive.org/cent/ URL, log in, click **System Configuration**, and then click **Utilities** tab.
- 3. In the Executive Utilities web page, click on the Apply Patch link from the Quick Links Menu.
- 4. Click **Browse** and select the file you downloaded from VIAVI Support.
- 5. Click Upload.
- 6. When the upload is complete, click Apply Patch.

This takes 10-15 minutes to complete. The TeraVM Executive does not reboot while the new threats are added. You will see a message stating that the upgrade is complete. The system is ready to use the cybersecurity updates.
