
Getting Access to the StandAlone Remote DSAM

In an internet browser go to http://catvsupport.com/index3.html


2. On your right, under DSAM/TPP/FDM click on V4.7 Stand Alone Remote DSAM App.




3. Once the .zip file downloads, extract the files in your desired destination folder (e.g. Desktop)



Open the folder in which you extracted the files into.



5. Click on RemoteDsam.jar (This will open up the Remote DSAM app).



- 6. In your physical DSAM unit do the following:
 - a. Go to Configure
 - b. Select General
 - c. Select Diagnostics
 - d. Choose Virtual DSAM
 - e. Wait for DSAM to pull an IP Address
- 7. Now in you Remote DSAM app do the following:
 - e. On the top row options, select connection
 - f. Then click on connect to meter (ctrl+c)
 - g. In the pop-up command screen, type the same IP Address that the DSAM has (Found under Virtual DSAM).
 - h. Once the light in the status bar is green on the DSAM, you will be connected and able to operate the DSAM virtually.

NOTE: Make sure your DSAM unit is connected to an Ethernet connection and to a power source.
